**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the Allenhurst Board of Education (herein referred to as "the Board") has submitted a tentative budget to the State of New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has received authorization to advertise said budget for the FY 2020 - 2021 school year from the Executive County Superintendent; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has advertised said budget in The Coaster newspaper on April 16, 2020 as required by law prior to hold the Public Hearing on the budget, and after discussion at the Public Hearing hereby declares the following;

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the

General Fund: \$370,076

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Revenue to support said budget will be as follows:

State Aid:	\$ 36,353
Budgeted Fund Balance:	\$ 73,393
Interest Income:	\$ 1,400
Local Tax Levy:	<u>\$258,930</u>
	\$370,076

**BE IT RESOLVED**, since the Board will make use of \$62,219 of Bank Cap for the purposes of increases in tuition, the tax levy does not exceed the legal cap as set forth by the State of New Jersey there will be no vote on said tax levy.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board hereby adopts the FY 2020 - 2021 budget.
